

# Syria Shelter & NFI Response July Overview

# Monthly Achievements

In July 2025, partners provided NFI assistance to 64,851 individuals with core NFI, including cash assistance.

Sector partners also met the shelter needs of 11,437 individuals in July through IDP site infrastructure improvements, dignified shelter construction, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

# As-Sweida Emergenc y Response as of 21st August

#### Needs

- Since mid-July 2025, rising inter-communal tensions and insecurity in As-Sweida Governorate have caused widespread displacement, creating urgent shelter and NFI needs. Over 160 collective sites have been identified across As-Sweida, Rural Damascus, and Dar'a.
- Hirjalleh site (Rural Damascus): discussed as a potential hosting area, with 450 vacant units requiring rehabilitation (doors, windows, fixtures).
- Inter-agency assessment (19-20 Aug, As-Sweida countryside): extensive home damage (looting, burning, vandalism) observed; most houses need minor repairs and debris clearance. Public facilities (schools, health centres) and basic services (water, electricity) are largely non-functional.
- Next steps: support shelter repairs, restore essential services, and address UXO risks, access constraints, and HLP issues in the post-emergency phase.

#### Response

Over 58,000 people (11,688 households) have been assisted so far, mainly through NFI distributions, with about half the kits complete and the rest partial. A total of 384 response actions have been recorded, led by UNHCR (60%), MWL (17%), AFH (5%), and other actors. Assistance has been concentrated in As-Sweida (39%) and Dar'a (39%), with Rural Damascus (12%) also covered. Upcoming distributions include IOM (2,091 kits), Oxfam (366 kits), and DRC (600 kits). The Sector is also preparing for a coordinated shelter repair response to support potential safe and dignified returns once access and security conditions allow.


