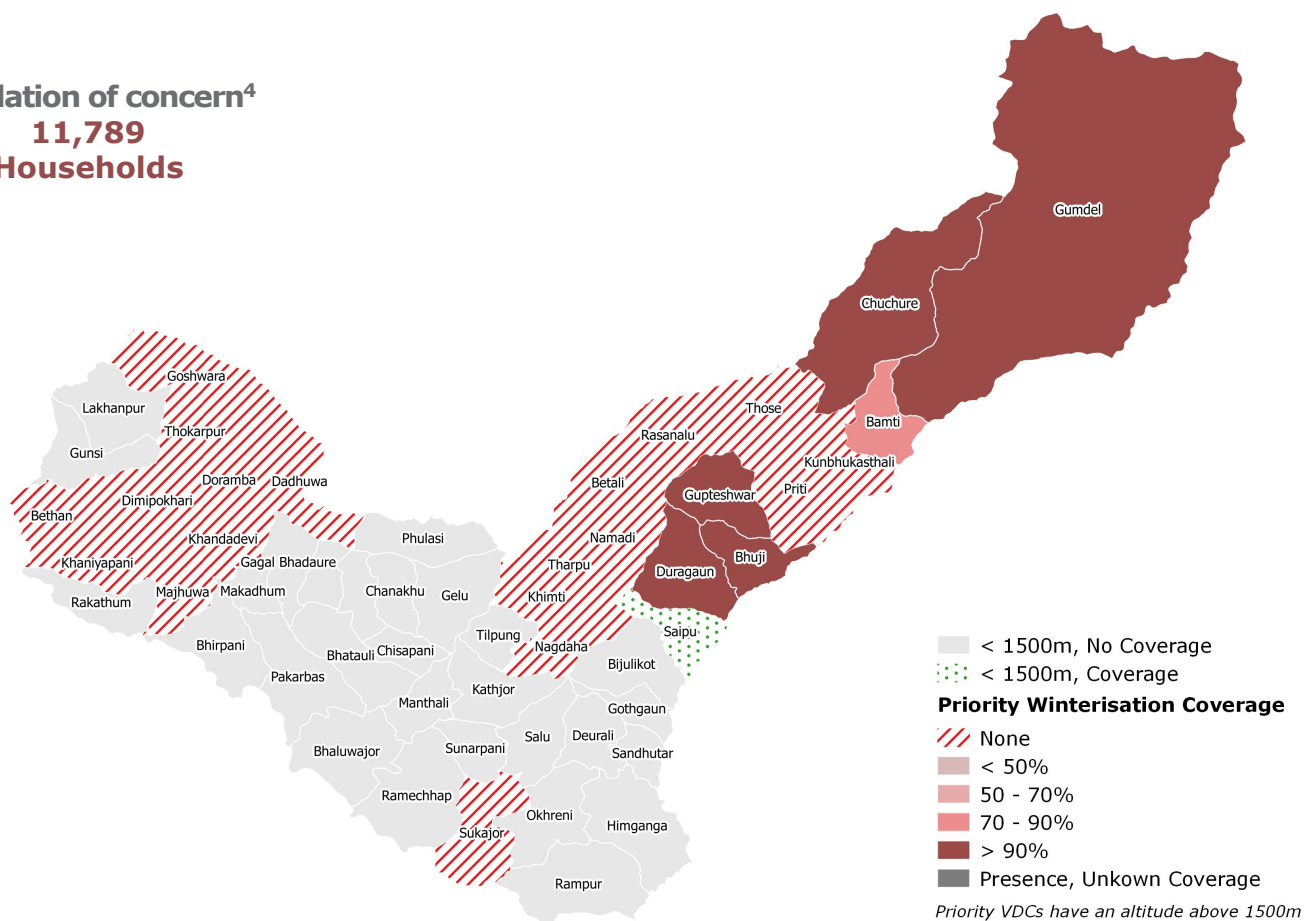

### Current Situation

- GOAL with the support of local partner agency, CDS, is assisting 1,371 HHs with full package of winter items in Chucure and Gumdel. This VDCs are above 1500m.
- No agencies have reported with the completion of any kind of distribution in Ramechhap.
- As a confirmed plan: ACTED, GOAL and United Vision Nepal will be distributing in kind to 3,277 HHs of 5 VDCs- Gupteshwor, Bhuji, Bampti, Duragaun and Saipu.

### Background

Ramechhap is one of the least served districts with limited distributions of tarpaulins at earlier stages of response. On the contrary, the number of CGI or its equivalent in cash distributions is sufficient with 52,530 distributions being sent to more than 39,000 affected households.
