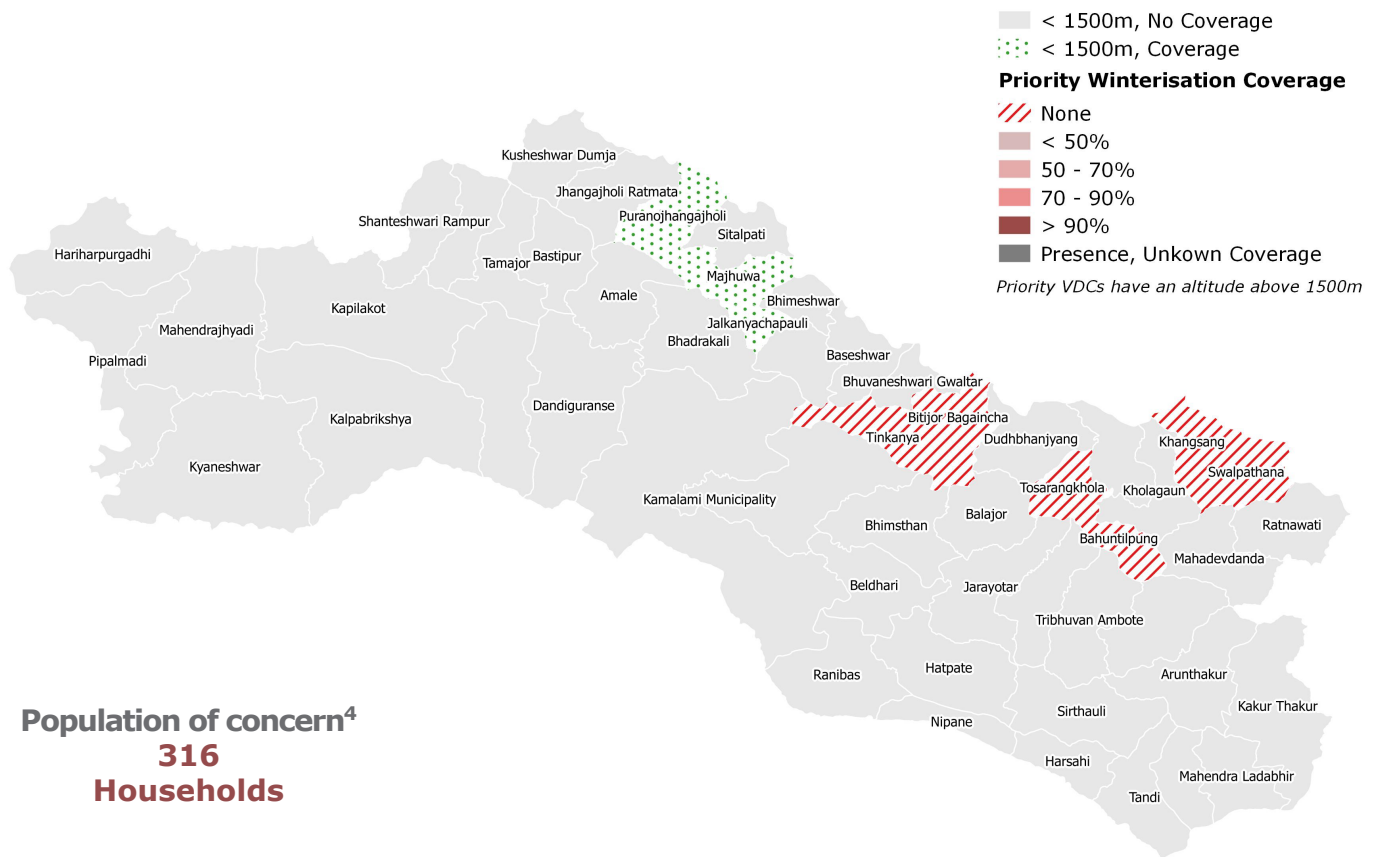

## Current Situation

- Nepal Red Cross Society has a plan to distributed NPR 10,000 to 2500 HHs in 3 VDCs- Jalkanya, Majhuwa and Purano Jhangajholi.
- No any other agencies have reported any kind of distribution. Neither any ongoing or completed distribution has been reported till date.
- Sindhuli has received very less assistance by agencies in comparison to the damages occurred.

## Background

Sindhuli is one of the least served districts and during earlier stages of relief, an insufficient amount of temporary shelter was distributed. Similarly, the total number of CGI or its equivalent in cash was also less than the required amount. CGI/Cash was distributed for 25,340 households whereas 28,225 households were affected.
