

## Dear Rear Admiral.

I am deeply concerned about the continued detention without charge or trial of Saifullah Paracha at Guantánamo. I appeal to you to release him unless he is charged and tried in accordance with international standards of fairness in an ordinary court — not a military commission.

Furthermore, I ask you to make sure he is given appropriate medical care and that independent medical experts be allowed to visit him in Guantánamo to assess his health.

I also call on you to ensure that Saifullah Paracha's family is being kept fully informed of his status, health and well-being, and that he has adequate communication with his family.

Finally I call on the US authorities to close the detention facility at Guantánamo Bay and either release the detainees held there or charge and try them in ordinary civilian courts in full accordance with international standards, without recourse to the death penalty.
