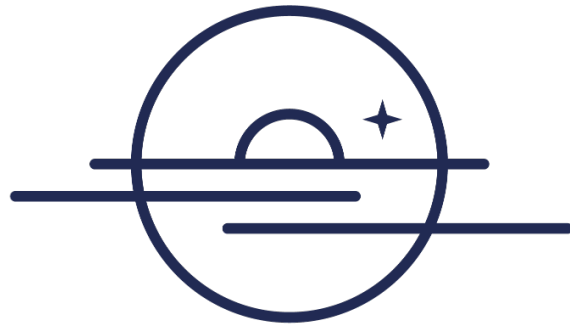

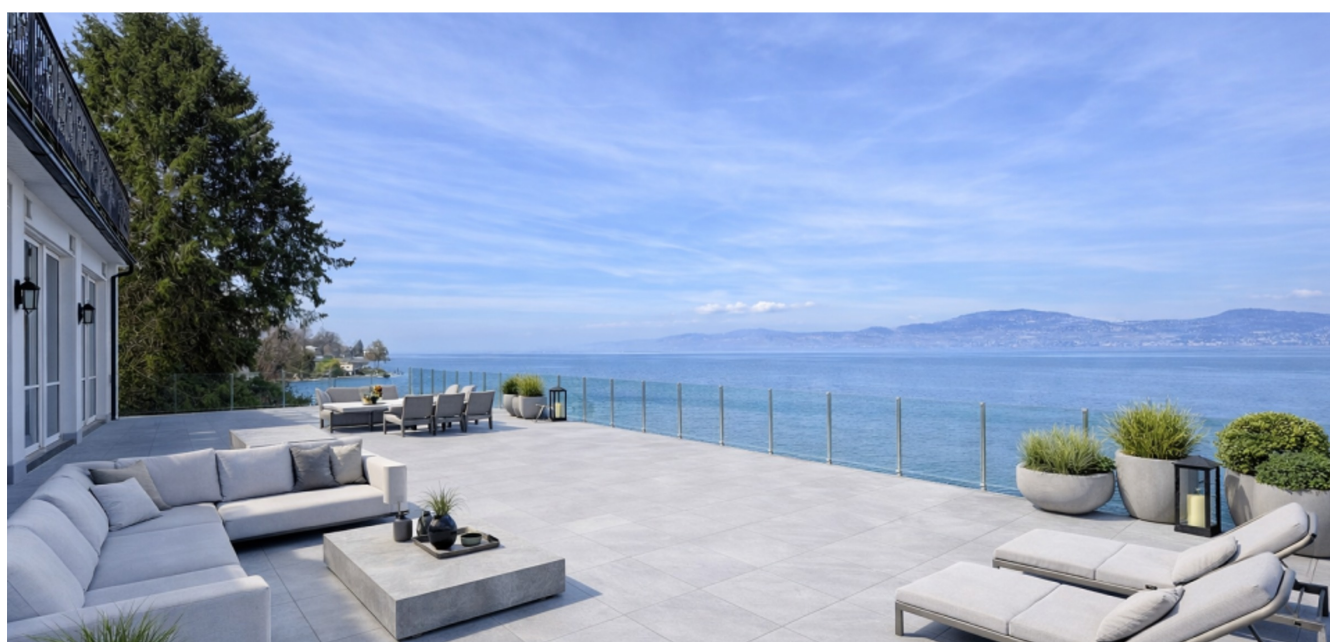

Situation

Saint-Gingolph is located near the French-Swiss border, on the southeastern shore of Lake Geneva and on the Morge River delta.

The town is located 17 kilometers east of Évian-les-Bains, 21 kilometers from Montreux, 22 kilometers from Monthey, and 23 kilometers from Thonon-les-Bains. The Swiss municipalities bordering Saint-Gingolph are Port-Valais and Vouvry.

Offering an exceptional living environment that combines the tranquility of the mountains with the relaxed lifestyle of lakeside living, its location is truly privileged, nestled between the majestic Lake Geneva and the Alpine peaks. This makes it a true gem of the region.

Water sports enthusiasts will appreciate the calm waters of Lake Geneva, ideal for sailing, canoeing and kayaking, or simply a refreshing swim.

Construction

The living spaces will be spacious and bright, featuring large floor-to-ceiling windows that let in abundant natural light. The planned flooring includes tile for the entryway, kitchen, and bathrooms, and hardwood floors in the bedrooms.

Radiator heating will be installed and powered by an air-to-water heat pump. Temperature control will be automatic via an outdoor sensor. The windowless bathrooms will have ventilation.

Each unit will have the necessary connections so that future owners can set up their laundry area according to their preferences.

As for the terraces, buyers will be able to select a fabric awning as an add-on from a selection of pre-selected models.

The construction materials chosen for the renovation of this building were selected for their high standards and long-lasting quality.
